Applicants

Air Force Academy cadets must be between the ages of 17 and 23 by July 1st of the year they enter the Academy. Age limits are set by public law (title 10) and cannot be waived. High school students can apply to the Academy as early as March of their junior year. Seniors can request applications through December 31st; however, we recommend that you get it by August or September so that you have plenty of time to accomplish everything you have to do.
